#### ***Under Other Business.***

During the course of the evening, it was brought to everyone's attention that a question had been raised earlier in the week by email about the attendance of Hashers dogs on the Hash. In the circle it was mentioned that there had been a ruling that dogs were not supposed to be brought to the Hash. This ruling was from some years back and had since been overlooked and not enforced. It was discussed and eventually a silent vote was conducted by those present being given the option to vote either Yes, No or mark the ballot paper with an X for abstaining to vote one way or the other. The vote was in favour of those saying YES, that Hashers could bring their dog to the **FH3**. It was announced before the closure of the circle and the following guidelines offered. That if any Hasher should bring a dog that became unruly, aggressive, or created similar issues out on the run or in the circle, that on the run the dog should be on a short leash, otherwise its owner would be requested to take it home and not bring it back. ALSO, that if the run site is at someone's home, that the Hasher must seek approval from the home owner before bringing any dog into the grounds of that home. As we currently have only one Hasher who regularly brings a small dog to the Hash, it was deemed that the question of dogs coming to the Hash was not seen to be a problem at the present time.
