Hare: Mental Disorder

This was like no other **Hash Run** that I've been on for a long time! Where to start? Well first of all our **GM, D Liva Rants** is still away, and we all know that age old saying 'Whilst the Cats Away, the Mice will Play'. Our **RA, White Pointer** also decided it was time to bugger off for a month and he dropped that into the On Secs lap last week just after the Hash Hymn had been sung... Let it be noted that any bad weather over the next month will be recorded and not accredited to any stand-in RA's but held over for **White Pointer** to answer to upon his return. The power of the **RA** should never stop...

The Hare for this week is not shy about setting long runs for the runners and **Mental Disorder** wasn't about to let us down. He had assistance from **Menstral Disorder & Arseholeo**, though I couldn't work out just what the later did? The run site was a great choice on the banks of the Swan River by the Garratt Road Bridge as it crosses over towards the Ascot Racecourse, at a well illuminated spot besides a rowing club house. We had **29 Hashers** turn out to enjoy the evenings Hash fun.
