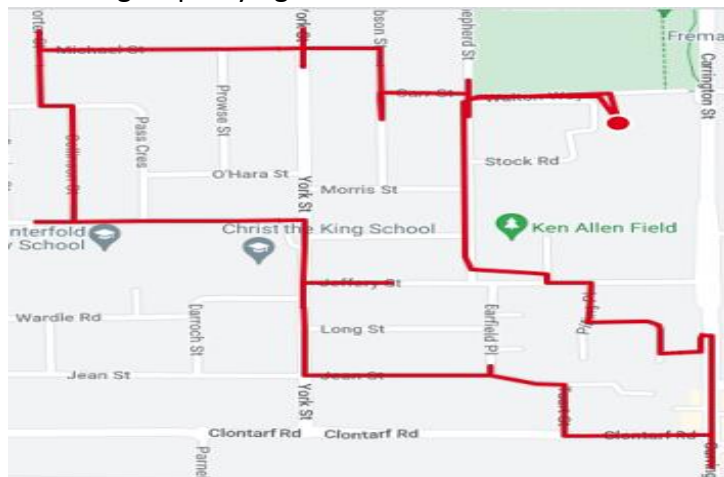
Hare: Inspector Gadget
