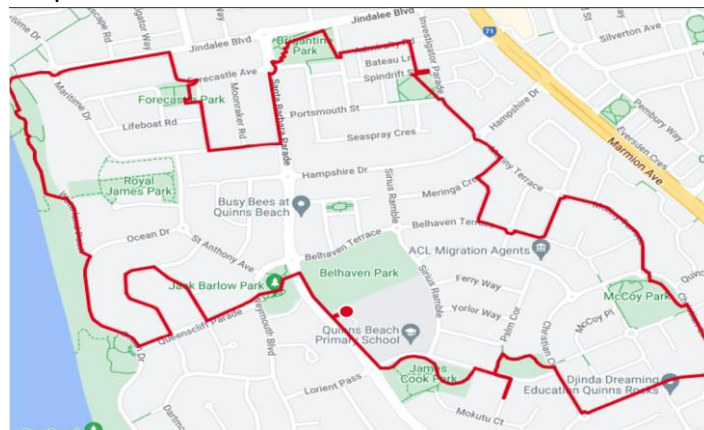
Hare: Ball Wrinkle
