The big RED BOOK (RB)

FH3 will commence using a “new” big RED BOOK in 2026 – 2 January 2026. Over the holiday period, I will complete an audit of FH3 hashers’ run numbers (to carry forward) based on Mal Adjusted most current Excel print out of 28 November 2025.

A cursory glance at last week’s “sign ins” reveals that some hashers are not updating their run numbers from week to week correctly. In a particular case the hasher increased their run total by 11 runs in one week.

Please take care when transferring your run number from week to week.

Pre-run Commentary

There was some confusion as to which carpark we should use; and which gazebo to use. The closest one obviously. FH3 hashers straggled from the carpark to the gazebo carrying their chairs etc. Everything was dandy until it was discovered that the toilet block was locked. The Circle

It is NOT recommended that the Circle be set up on sloping ground, on the side of a hill, the middle of a car park, or on a municipal oval where there is any risk of the sprinkler system drenching the seated hashers; or close to or with “sniffing” distance of an ablution block or municipal rubbish bins.
