3. All other committee positions will remain with the current position-holders until the final decision has been made. The GM can ask them to remain, or choose someone else, as is the usual process.

This situation has caused a lot of dis-harmony among our members, but we must keep the good of the club first and foremost in our minds. Everyone has their opinion, and should be allowed to speak their piece, or raise questions, and be answered in a respectful manner. The raised voices and anger that was on show during the discussion was not called for and did nothing to advance the resolution. I hope that we can all conduct ourselves with more restraint as we move forward.
